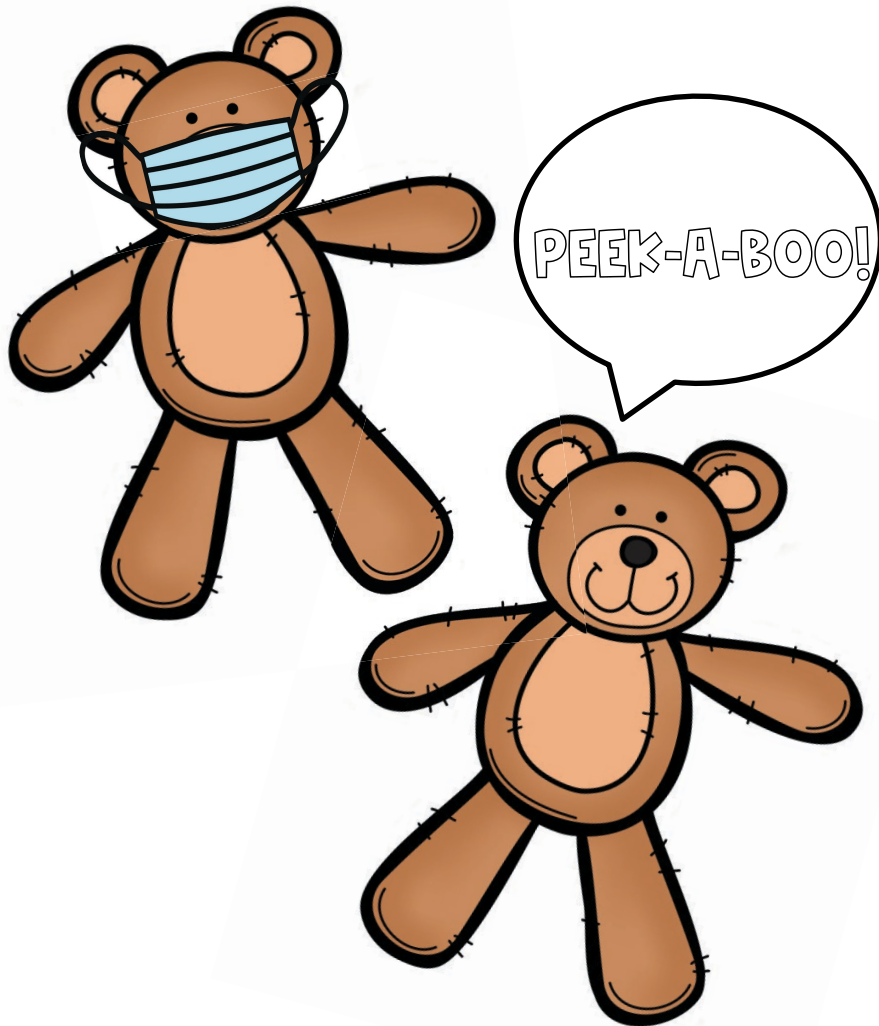
A lot of people are wearing
masks right now.



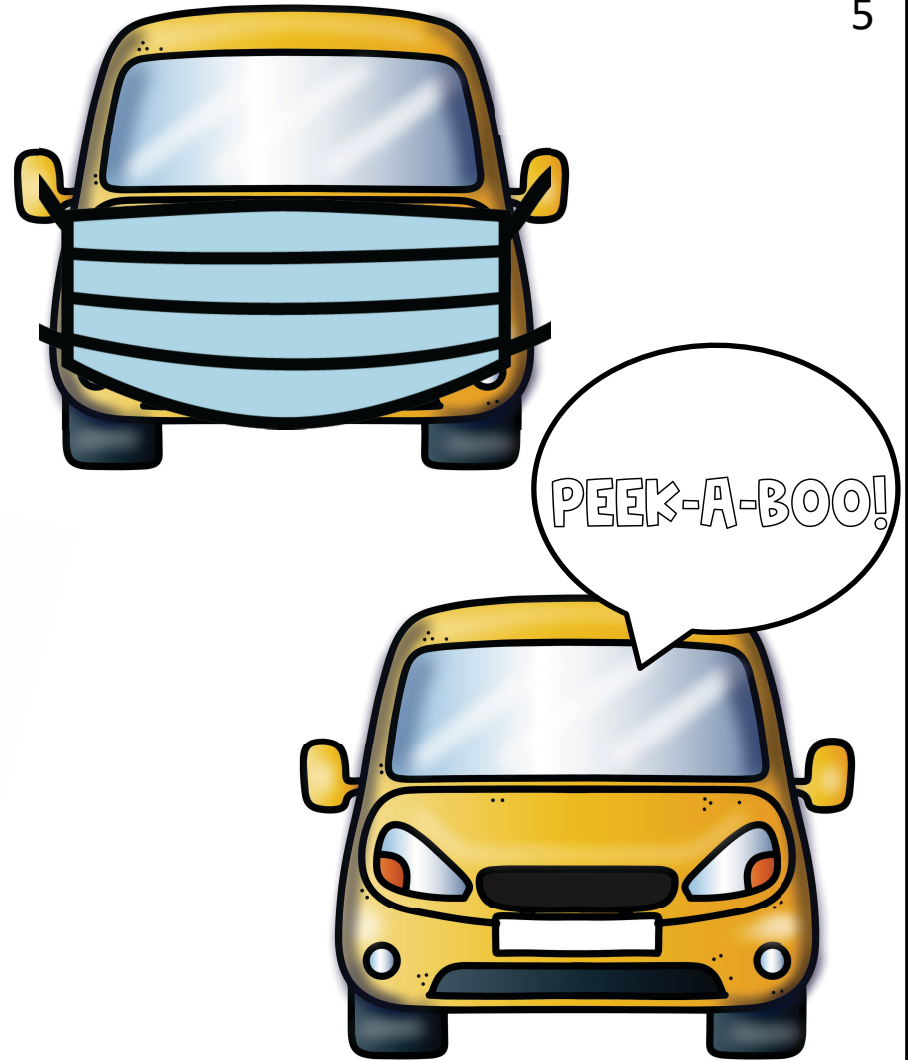
I can play with a mask and put it on my stuffed animals, dolls and toys.



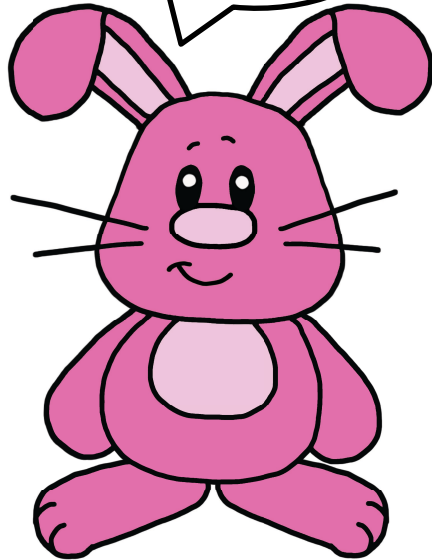
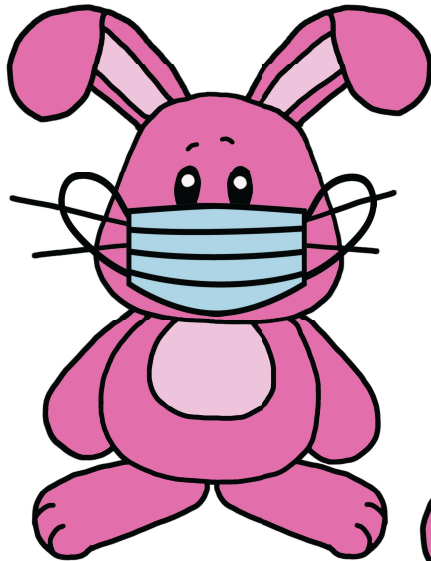
Look! My doll has a mask on. Take it off and we can play peek-a-boo.



Now it's the bear's turn. Let's play peek-a-boo with the mask!

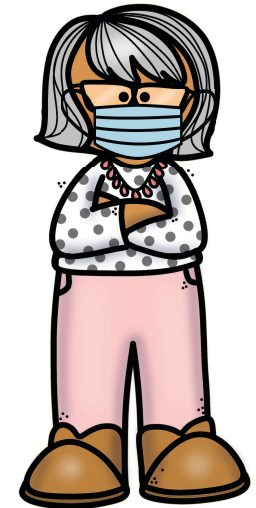
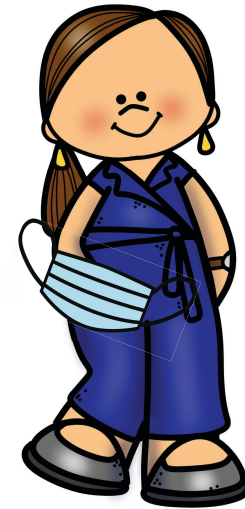


Now, let's play peek-a-boo with the toy car!

I can practice putting my mask on and taking it off.



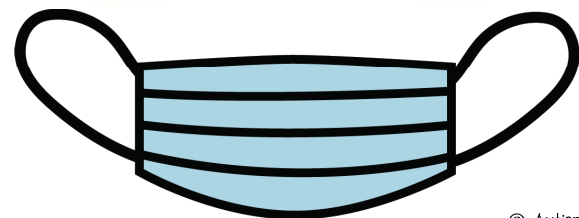
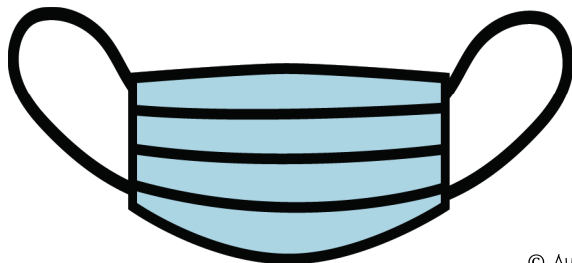
It can be fun to play with my mask and my toys together!

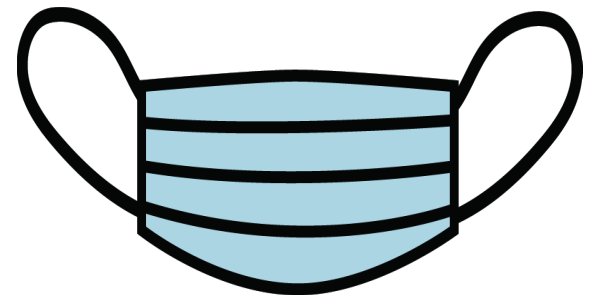
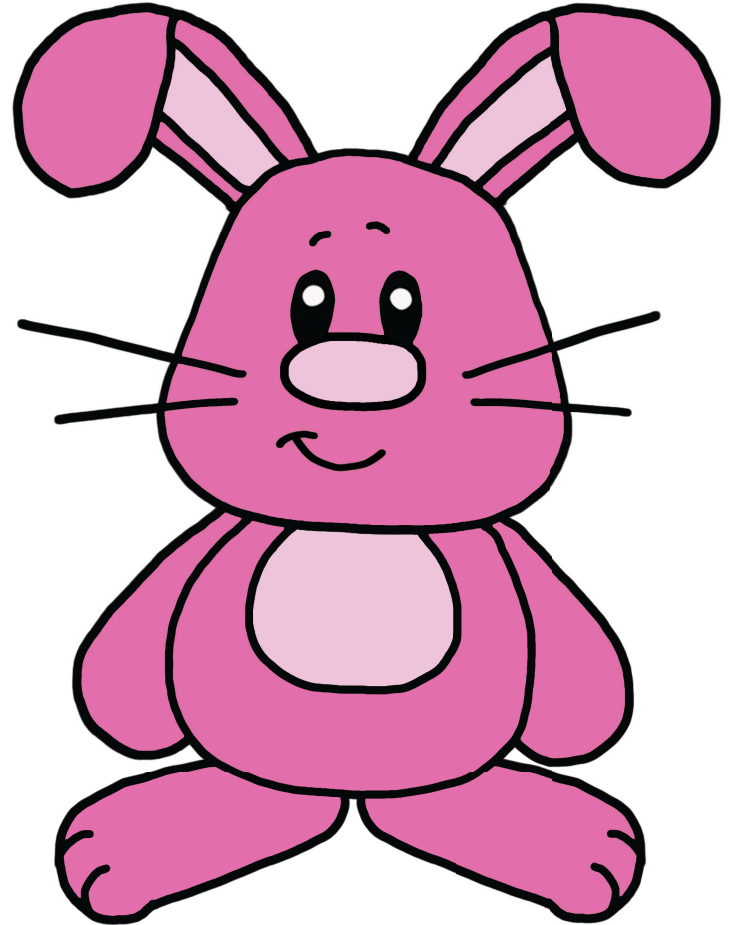
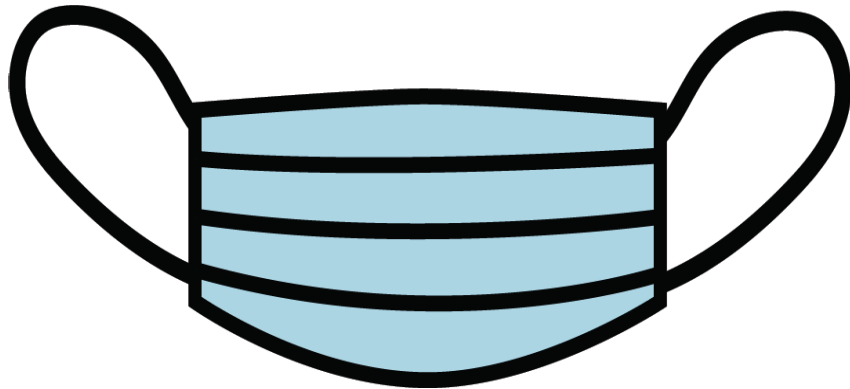

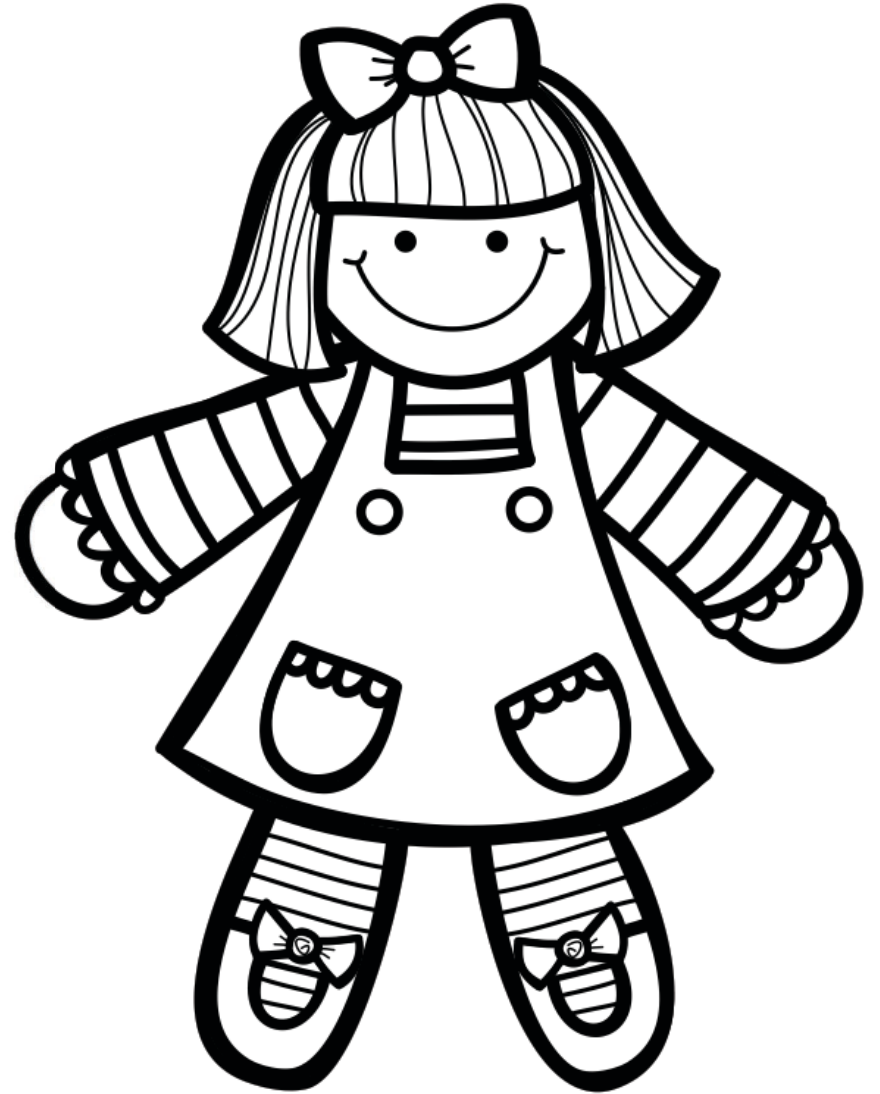
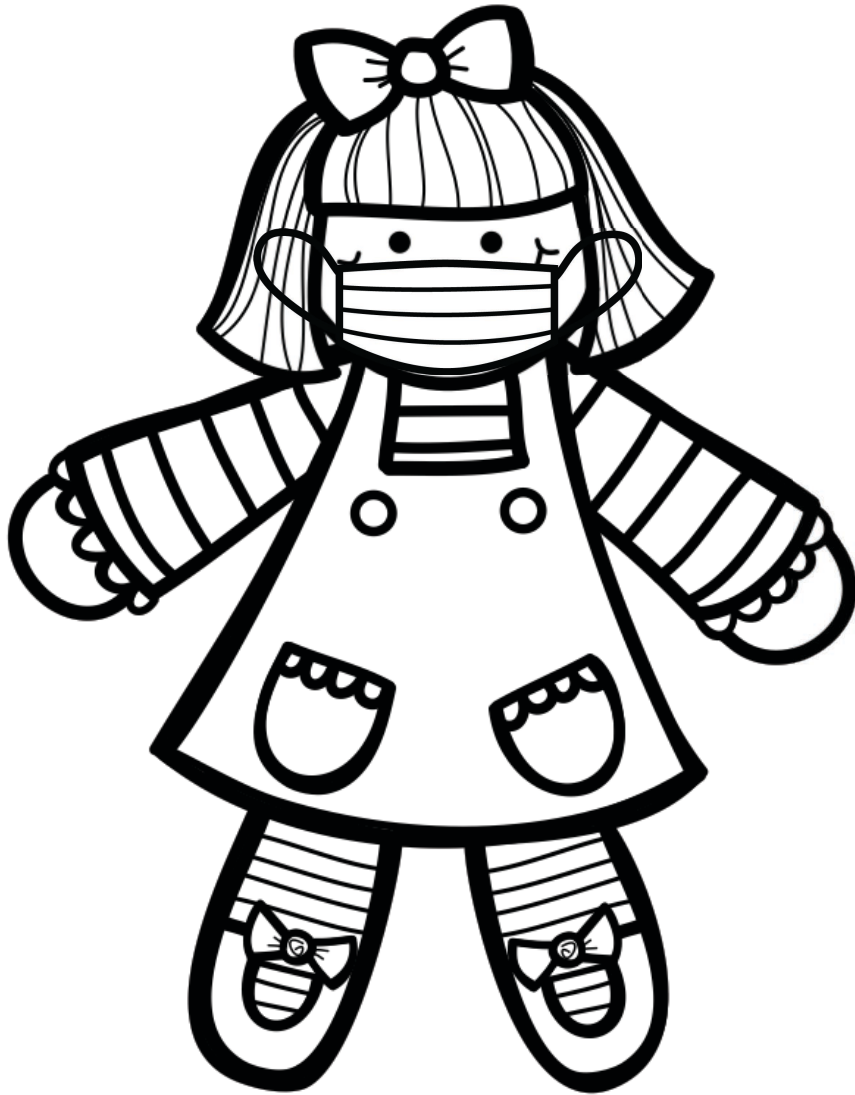
Cut the pictures on the following pages out for kids to play with. They can practice putting the paper mask on and off the pictures and playing peek-a-boo.

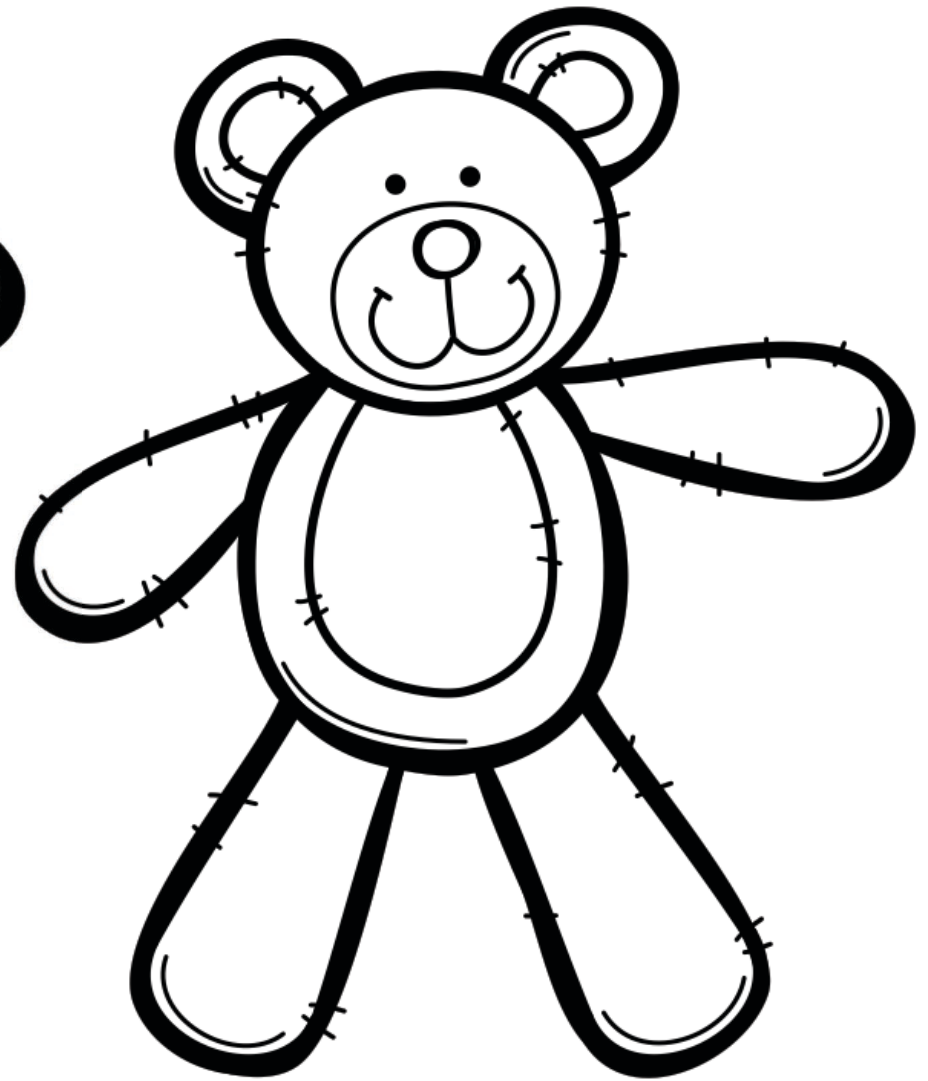
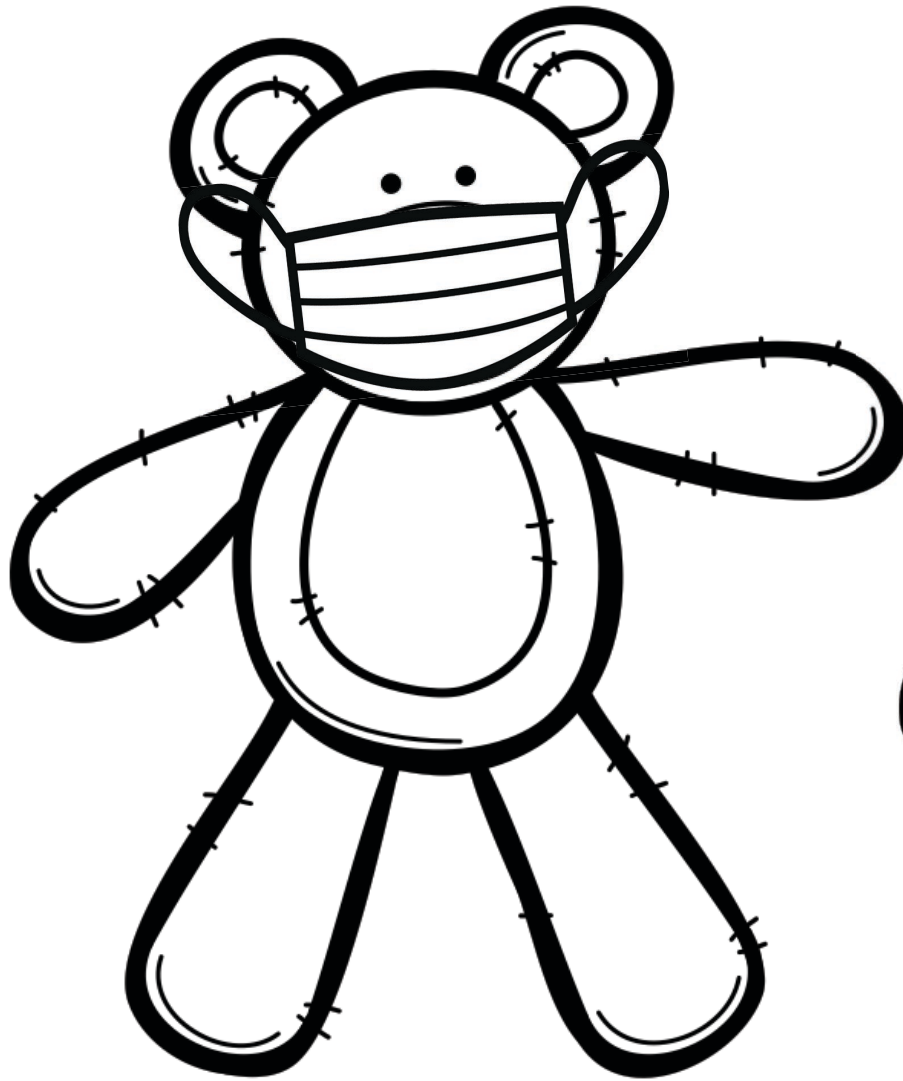
There are also some coloring pages for children to color some scenes and characters wearing masks.

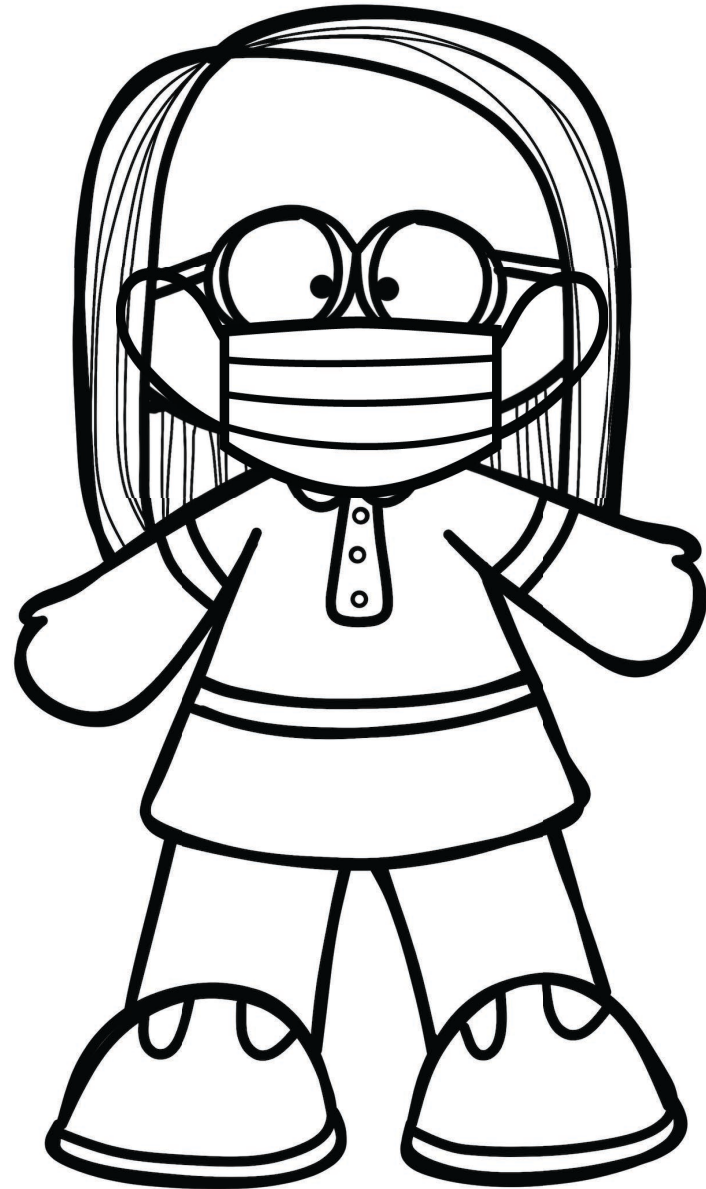
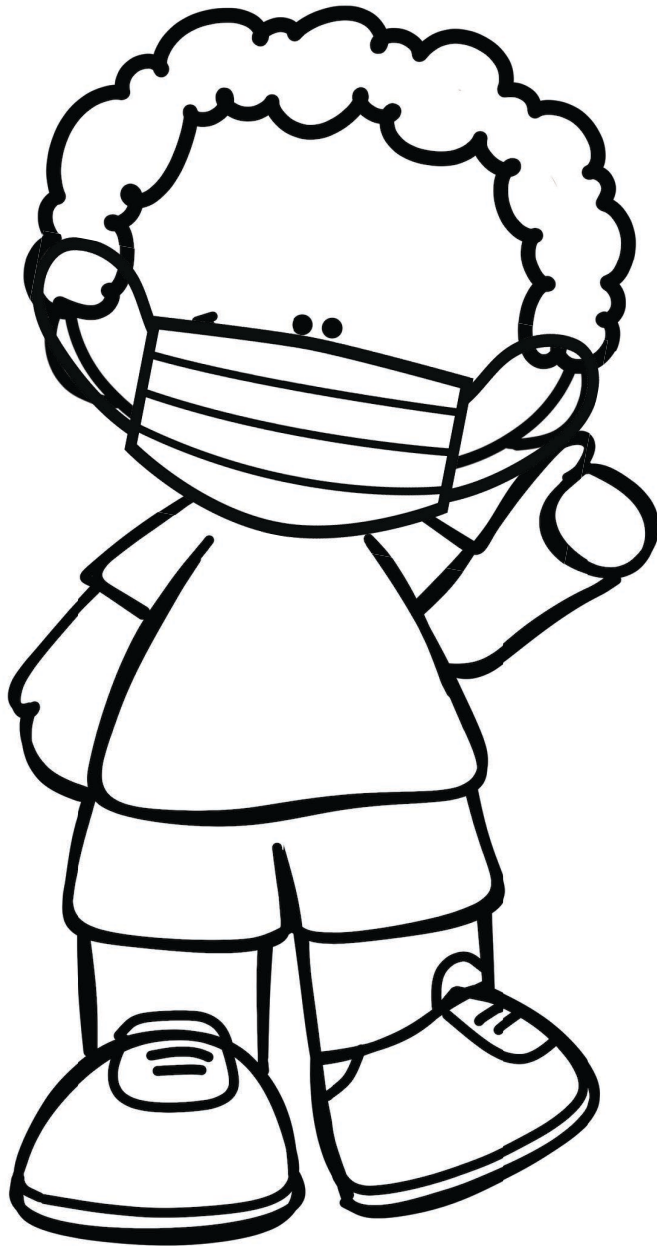
Please note: The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends that children age 2 and under do NOT wear masks.

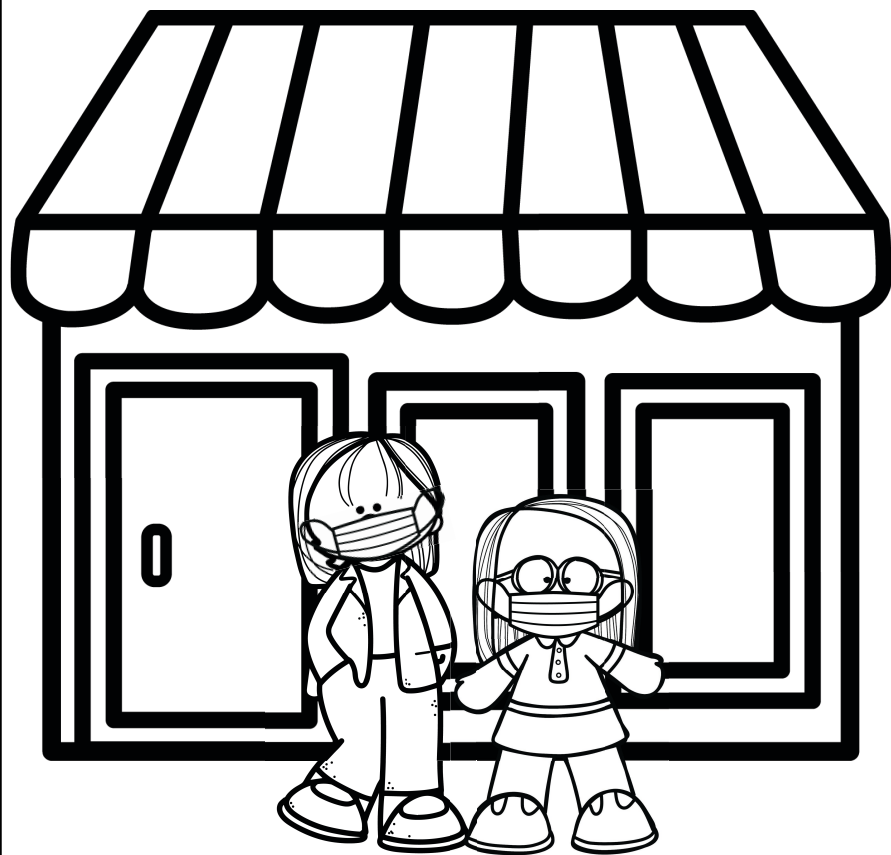


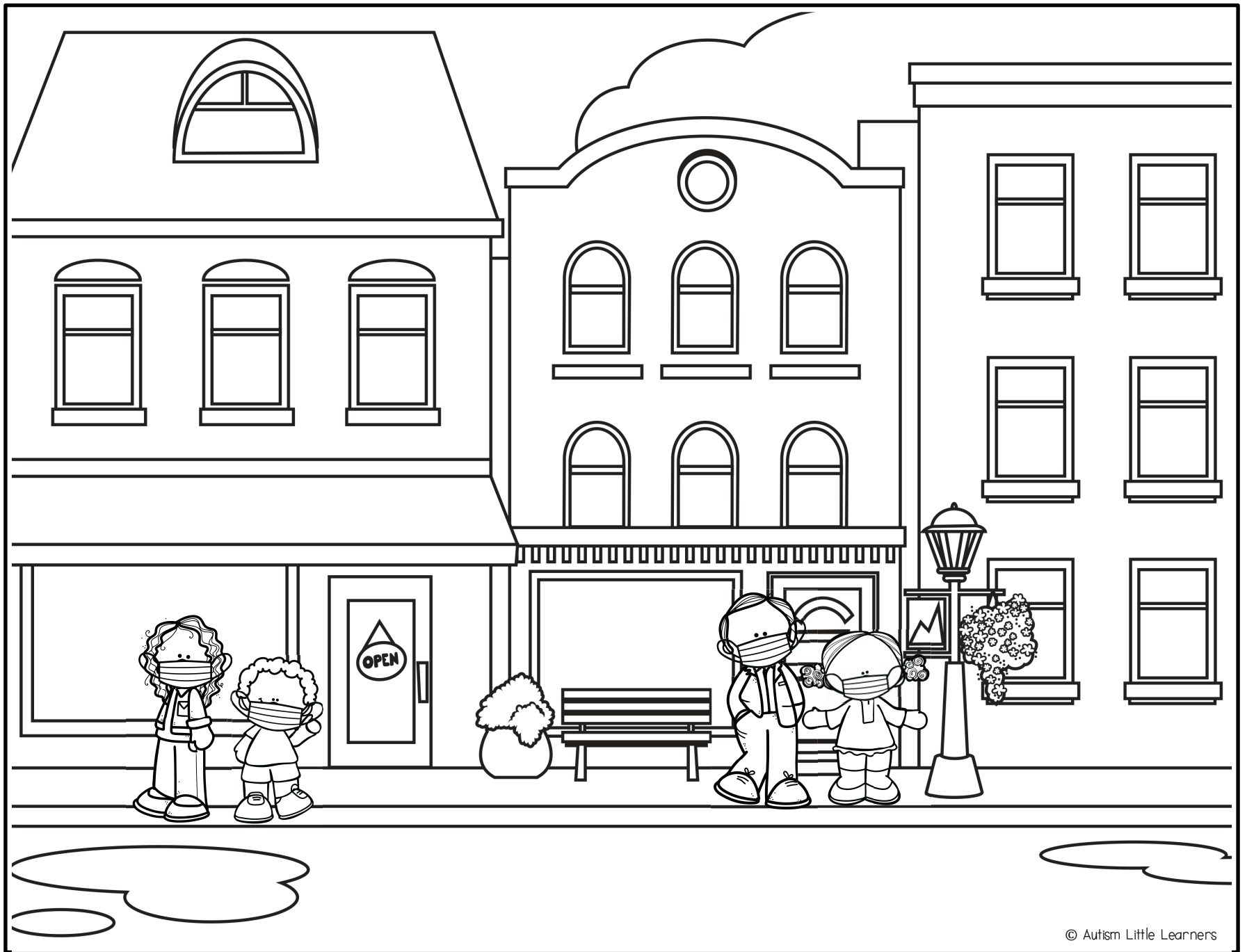


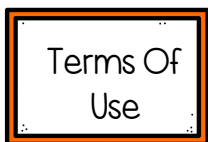
