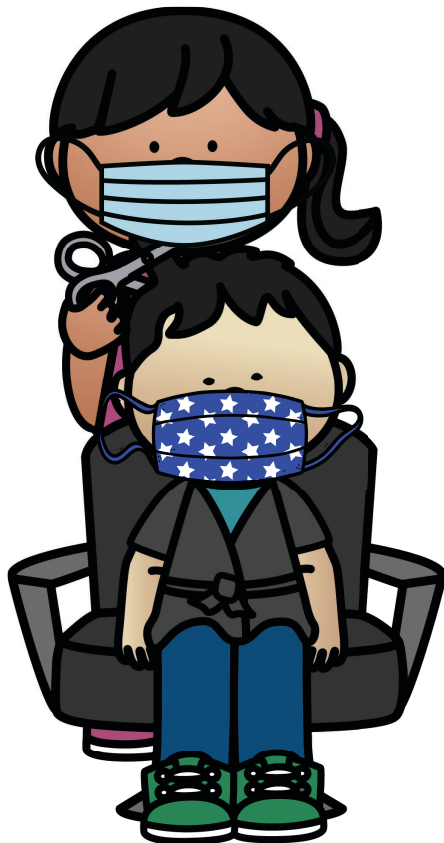
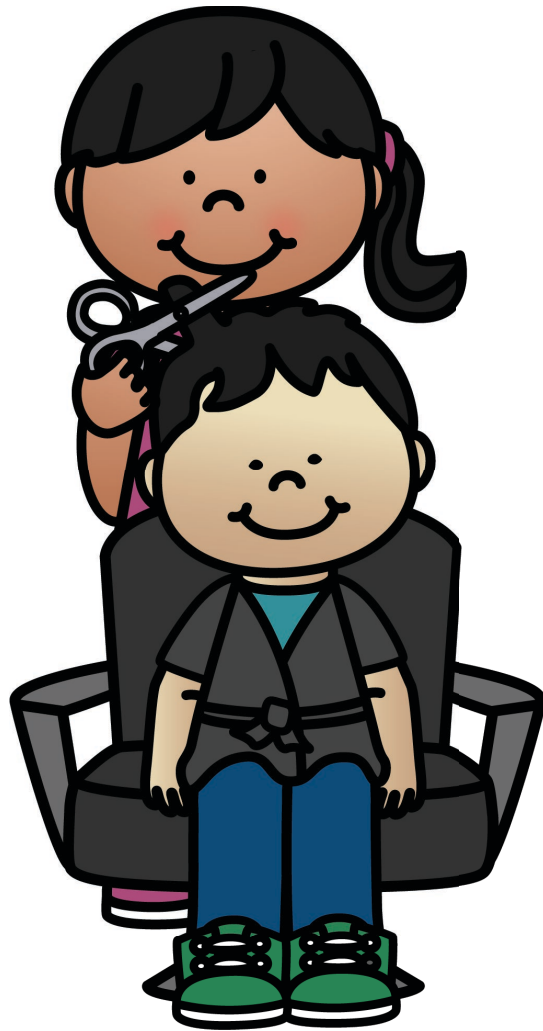


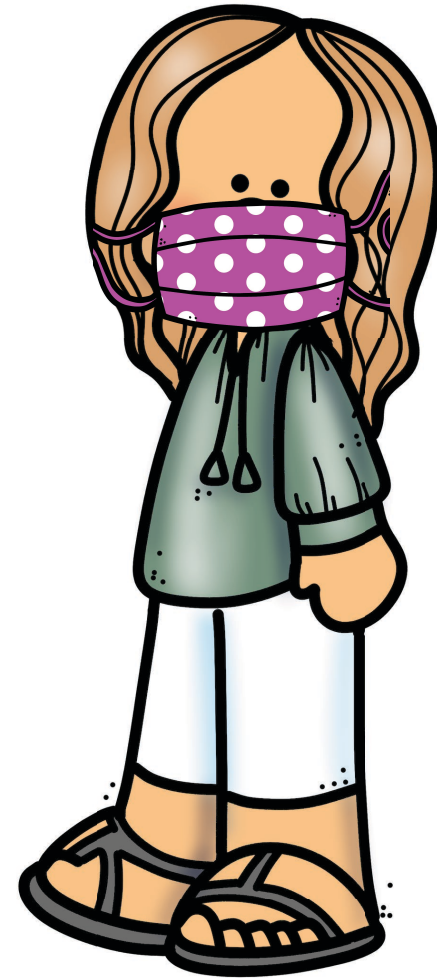
# Getting a haircut with masks

I am used to.



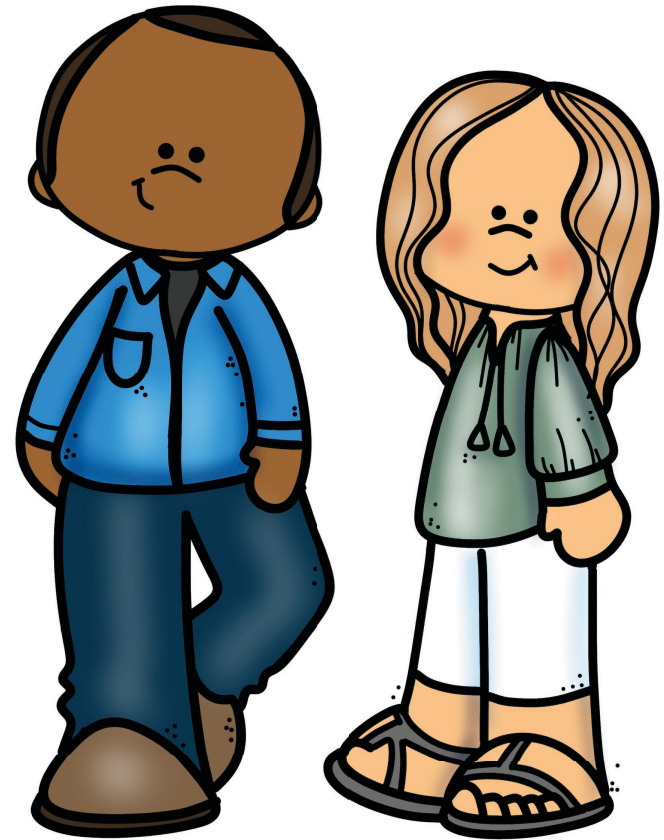
Usually when I get my hair cut, we don't wear masks.



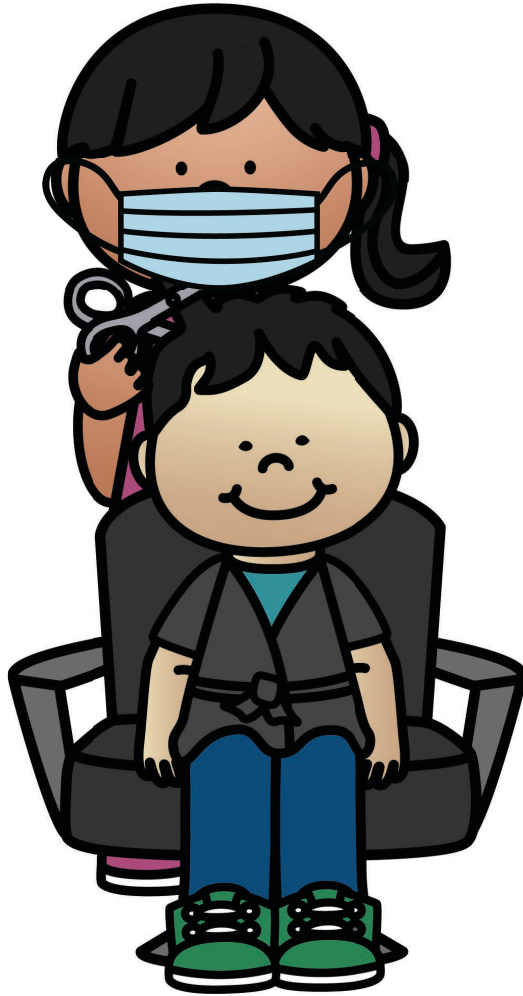
But, for a while it will be different. My hair stylist will be wearing a mask.



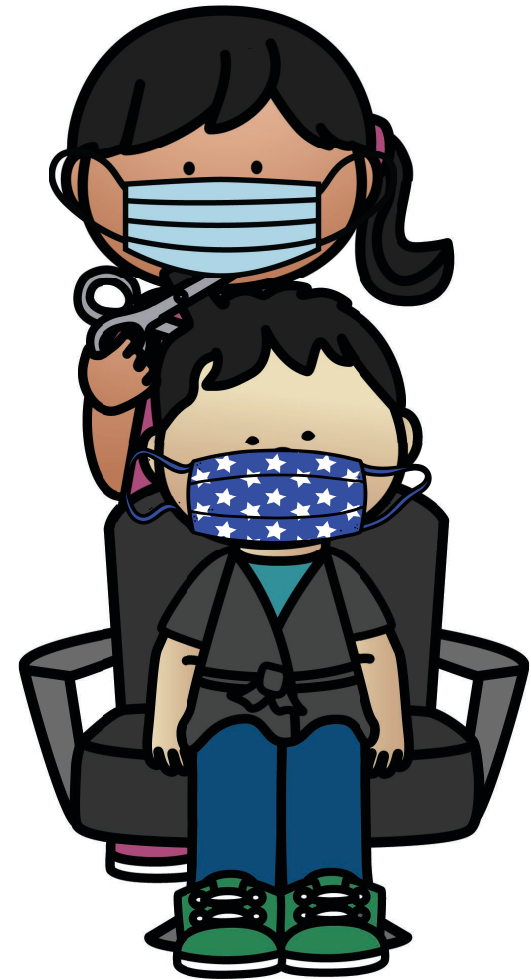
It's okay! He or

mouth and a nose.



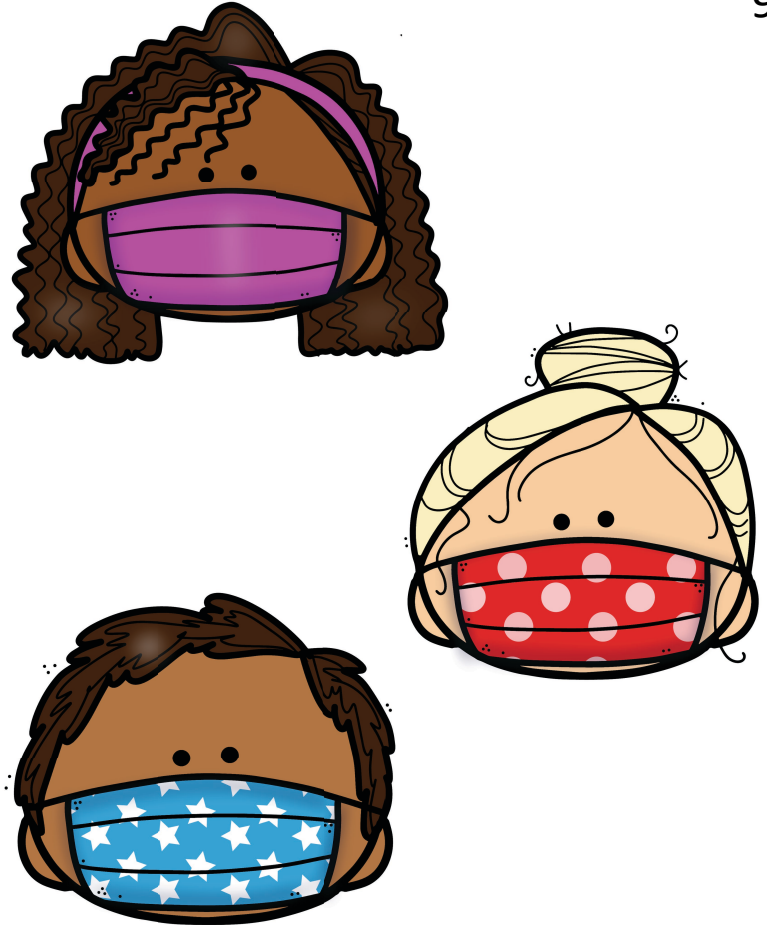
At some salons, the hair

wears a mask.



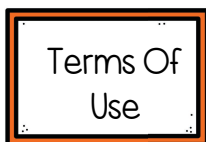
In other salons, we both

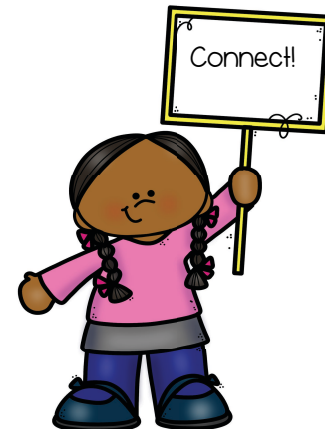
